

MORGAN'S PHOTOGRAPHY WINS BEST IN SHOW AT HORTT45

Katherine Morgan, of Boca Raton, has been honored with BEST IN SHOW for photography at the HORTT45 opening at Artserve Saturday June 10, 2006 at 6:00 PM.

Renowned for presenting the best of the region, the famous HORTT45 Exhibition is in its 45th season of celebrating the visual arts in South Florida.

Juror Tom McPherson, Director, Mobile Museum of Art selected two of photographer Katherine "Katy" Morgan's works for the HORTT45 and one for the Salon des Refuses.

HORTT 45, the areas oldest and most prestigious juried show, has teamed with the Broward Art Guild, Broward County's oldest arts organization, and sponsored by art-loving individual and corporate donors committed to advancing the cultural life of South Florida.

Also in the exhibition is her "...serenity II" is one of a series of 5 macro single subject petals from the beautiful cyclamen flowering plant. Ms Morgan feels that the peacefulness of the images is suitable not only for the works individually, but also suitable subjects for meditation, as well. They are both limited edition works and carry certification of authenticity

HORTT 45 is open to all artists living or working in South Florida. Emerging young artists as well as seasoned veterans rival for the chance to have a shot at the \$2500 BEST IN SHOW cash prize presented with full media attention at a gala public AWARDS CEREMONY on June 10th beginning at 6:00 PM at the J.M.Family Enterprises Gallery at ARTSERVE in Fort Lauderdale.

Running through July 5, 2006, the HORTT45 season is topped off by the Broward Art Guild's storied Salon des Refuses Exhibition, the popular sister-event staged in boisterous true French style. During the opening celebration a week following the HORTT Exhibition opening 6:00 PM on JUNE 17, 2006, attendees award their popular favorites from the entries not accepted into the "official" HORTT 45 Competition.

The Salon will be showing "...minor adjustments", some say it is her signature work. She just thinks it is the most serendipitous candid with which she has been blessed. It always brings a smile to the viewing public..
